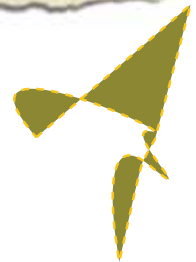

**Sheila Ghidini** has taught art to children for over 30 years. She has been teaching at the Cathedral School for Boys in San Francisco since 1995. She has taught art at the Chinese American School, the San Francisco Art Education Project and coordinated the Children's Visual Arts Program for the San Francisco Arts Commission.

She has a B.F.A. in art and art education from the Hartford Art School of the University of Hartford in Connecticut and an M.F.A. from the University of California, Berkeley. Classes are being offered in her studio in San Francisco. Children will have the opportunity to see work in progress and gain understanding of the process of art making and the context of a working professional artist.

Classes are \$172.00 for 4 sessions. Registration is required before the class begins since enrollment is limited. Each class will have no more than 4 students to ensure individualized attention.



## WINTER PROGRAMS

Classes offered provide opportunities for children and their parents to work together in hands-on projects, focusing on creativity, self-expression, skill development and fun!

**MIXED MEDIA ART SAT.3-4:30**

This class will combine a number of different ways of working with materials, from drawing + painting to collage + building. Materials used will be recycled children's toys, games, stuffed animals and books. They will be taken apart and rebuilt into new and different art objects. Imagination and creativity expand, as a toy becomes something never seen before!

Parents are encouraged to participate in all projects, either by creating their own works of art or by collaborating with their child to build something together. This class is ideal for a 2nd-5th graders.

**DRAWING AND PAINTING SAT.4:30-5**

Drawing and painting skills will be taught in this class. Pencil, pastels, charcoal and watercolor painting will be focused on. Best suited for 3rd-7th graders.
